Here are the details for the day.

TIMING:

1 PM – Concert begins. CHAMBER CHOIR students report to the CHOIR RM. for rehearsal.

2:30 PM – CHAMBER CHOIR opens ACT 3 of the concert

3:00 PM – Concert ends.

7 PM – Evening concert begins. MEN'S ENSEMBLE students report to the CHOIR RM. for rehearsal

8:30 PM – MEN'S ENSEMBLE opens ACT 3 of the evening concert.

9:00 PM – Concert ends.

CONCERT ATTIRE:

- ✓ Select Choir uniform – all select choir students should have been fitted for a uniform at this point. Students should take uniforms home and keep them until the end of the year.
- ✓ Please make sure students are wearing black dress shoes.
