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Course Description	Guitar Class is focused on providing students with a practical foundation in guitar technique. Students will learn how to play chords and melodies on the guitar in various styles using chord symbols and tablature. Students will also learn about the structure of chord progressions and how they can be applied to songwriting. Musicians from beginner to advanced are all welcome. Guitars will be provided for use during class.
