MODERN ART AND DESIGN COURSE OF STUDY:

This eighteen week course is an extension of elementary art concepts, skills and prior experiences. The studio units focused upon include advanced intermediate skills and concepts in drawing, painting, commercial art, architecture, crafts, and animation. In Art History, students will study the artistic styles that were developed beginning in 1915 until the end of the twentieth century. A variety of art movements and artists will be explored. Students will further develop knowledge and skills related to the disciplines of Art Criticism, Aesthetics and Philosophy, through various activities including critiques, class discussions, reflections, and writing.

SECOND CHANCE LEARNING: *If you want to improve your art grade, all projects are re-workable!*

As time permits, all students may have as many opportunities as possible. Complete project "Re-dos" must be completed in school and not during normal class time. Revising sketches can be done during class, if all other work is completed. Extenuating circumstances, will be evaluated on a case by case basis

Students must self-advocate and initiate the opportunity for reteaching. Time will be given at resource for re-teaching but only if students use class time efficiently.
