What are some modern technologies/conveniences?

Challenge: Pick one non-school day between now and the due date and give up as many technological advances and modern conveniences as you can for 24-hours. You will keep a journal of your experience living without the technology you are used to in 2013.

Requirements:

1. You must write a journal entry at least three times on the day that you give up the technology. The first journal entry should be as soon as you wake up. The second journal entry should be half way through your day and the final entry should be before you go to sleep that night.
2. Begin each journal entry with the time you are writing.
3. Include in the entries how you are feeling about not having the modern conveniences of today, how you are spending your time, and what must life have been like for children your age who lived in 1900.
4. Your last entry should include why you were or were not able to give up certain technologies.
5. Your journals will be graded. Use your best spelling, grammar, and handwriting. Each entry should be completed on a separate piece of paper. You are **NOT** to use a computer to type your journal entries.
