CBSD Academic Integrity Policy on use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) & ChatGPT

Academic Integrity involves helping maintain a culture of honesty, trust, fairness, respect, and responsibility in all aspects of learning. Academic integrity means avoiding cheating and plagiarism in all forms and taking responsibility and ownership of your own work.

The technology that now surrounds our daily lives demands even more care and integrity; scholars need to be even more mindful of what constitutes academic misconduct and ensure that work created and submitted is in alignment with teacher-lead parameters regarding Al use.

Teachers may set the following boundaries when assigning learning activities throughout the course:



Al is prohibited: This learning opportunity assumes that all work submitted by students will be generated by the students themselves, working individually or in groups. Students should not have another person/entity do the writing of any substantive portion of an assignment for them, which includes hiring a person or a company to write assignments and using artificial intelligence tools like ChatGPT.



Al is allowed with attribution: Use of Al tools are permitted in this course/assignment for students who wish to use them. To adhere to our scholarly values, students must cite any Al-generated material that informed their work (this includes in-text citations and/or use of quotations, and in your reference list). Using an Al tool to generate content without proper attribution qualifies as academic dishonesty.



Al is encouraged with certain tasks and with attribution: You can choose to use Al tools to help brainstorm assignments or projects or to revise existing work you have written. When you submit your assignment, I expect you to clearly attribute what text was generated by the Al tool (e.g., Al-generated text appears in a different colored font, quoted directly in the text, or use an in-text parenthetical citation).
