1. What is the topic of the article?
2. Who wrote the article, and what are the person's qualifications for writing such an article?  
Meaning, what makes them an expert?
3. Describe what type of research was done to support this article. How was the data collected?
4. When was the article written? **MUST BE WITHIN TWO YEARS** of today's date.
5. How does someone like you benefit from the information? Give at least two answers.
6. Is there any information that would be beneficial to food professionals? If so, what is it?
7. How does this information relate to us in the foods classroom? Give at least two answers.
8. How could this information benefit people who cook at home? Give at least two answers.
9. What are two specific suggestions given in the article?
10. What do you think is the most beneficial information for people your age in this article?  
Explain.
