



SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Central Bucks School District attendance policies conform to the Pennsylvania School Code sections 1326 to 1333 dealing with compulsory school attendance. "Every child of compulsory school age having a legal residence in this Commonwealth... is required to attend a day school in which the subjects and activities prescribed by the standards of the State Board of Education are taught."

Online Absence Request (See below for directions on how to report an absence.)

- Parents and guardians will be able to submit absence requests via the <u>Parent Portal</u>. Parents can request a full day absence, early dismissal, or late arrival.
- Absence requests will be reviewed by School Attendance Staff and approved or denied.
- Requests made using the Parent Portal will also serve as the excuse for the absence. Parents will not be required to submit an
 excuse either electronic or written.
- Parents/Guardians are required to notify the school at least three (3) days prior to the absences covered by this regulation so
 that the student may obtain work to keep current with class progress. Each school has a form Approved Absence Request.
- For all vacation requests, please utilize that option throught the Parent Portal. Your school attendance office will contact you with any additional information that is required.

Please be sure to visit the Attendance web page for your child's school for specific procedures for reporting an absence. This page is located under "Our School" on each school's website.

We are excited to introduce our **NEW** contactless application and paperwork submission process **to our CBSD volunteers**. You can now **upload** your clearances online through our Volunteer Tracker portal. Please click **App Garden-Volunteer Tracker** to sign-up and review the clearance requirements. **Sign-up is required for** both **New** and **Returning Volunteers!**

The following information is intended for *volunteers* (classroom, school, coach, and similar NON-PAID positions. If you are being compensated through CBSD by paycheck, parent fund or student fund; you are NOT a Volunteer.

The Volunteer Tracker will allow you to sign-up for volunteer opportunities specific to your building and/or classroom of choice. You will receive communication via email to update you on the latest upcoming event(s), clearance expiration, and to review your participation level. Clearances/Background Checks are valid for five (5) years.

Required Documents:

Clearances: Links to the state's websites are below.

- PA State Police Criminal Background Check Click the "Certification Form" link to save and print your
 official certificate.
- PA Child Abuse History Certification Click "Create Individual Account" (create Keystone ID) and keep record
 of this information to access your results. Important Note: Use Firefox or Edge.
- FBI Fingerprinting (2 Options): Enter the service code for VOLUNTEERS: 1KG6Y3 OR complete the residency
 <u>Volunteer Affidavit</u> if you have lived in PA for the past 10 consecutive years or more. Notary services are
 available at the CBSD Administration Office at 20 Welden Drive from 8:30am 4:00pm, free of charge.

 ${\it IMPORTANT NOTE: Employment clearances are acceptable for volunteer purposes, BUT volunteer clearances are not acceptable for employment purposes.}$

ELD PROGRAM




This program gives our multilingual learners more exposure to the CB curriculum to strengthen their skills in reading, writing, listening, and speaking.







The Central Bucks Community School












LOWER LEVEL (K-2) BUILDING DESIGN...

UPPER LEVEL (3-6) BUILDING DESIGN...






