Create two playing cards in class to demonstrate your knowledge of selections, cutting, pasting, composition, layout, fonts, layer effects, filters, and color changing.

In both of your cards you must complete the following objectives.

- 1. Create a card using the number or royal letter with a suit of your choice.
- 2. Use a filter(s) in your card to add to the creative effect of the design of the card.
- 3. Show an inner rectangle with a different photo than that outer rectangle.
- 4. Have part of each card show a 3D aspect to its design by having an overlapping photo show depth.
- 5. Have a clear theme for each card Surfing, traveling, music, sports, sweets, etc.

Playing Card 1 – This card can be made using internet pictures. This is worth 50 points.

Playing Card 2 – This card must be made using original pictures that you have taken with your digital camera/smartphone. This is worth 50 points.

Total points for this assignment - 100 points.
