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Question 1: Are you going to take TWO music ensembles? (such as: Band/Orchestra or Band/Choir)

- If **Yes**, proceed to question 3
- In **No**, proceed to guestion 2

Question 2: Which A/B Course(s) do you want to take on the opposite of your music ensemble?

- a. PE/HEALTH (7062) (18-week a/b) (Most 10th graders pick this option and one other, although PE can be deferred to another year)
- b. MUSIC ELECTIVE:
 - i. MUSIC THEORY (highly recommended for 10th grade any and all Music students!)
 - AP Music Theory will not run at CB East in 2020-2021, but will run in the following year. Students considering AP
 Music Theory should very seriously consider taking music theory first. It is possible to test in to the AP Music Theory
 section, but not likely.

- C. NON-MUSIC ELECTIVE:

Question 3: Do you plan to take TWO Science classes (Biology and Chemistry) in 10th grade year?

- If YES, you would select "MODERN WORLD HISTORY" (honors or academic) as your S.S. Credit to make music fit into your schedule.
- If NO, you have the option of taking either AP EUROPEAN HISTORY (27 weeks) or Modern World History (18 weeks)
- For your consideration: If you want to schedule, AP Euro History, TWO science courses, MUSIC, and English, Math, World Language, then <u>Music WILL NOT fit in this schedule.</u>

Start with your Social Studies Course selection:

- If you chose **AP Euro History**: fill it in block 4 for MP 1,2,3. This will leave one 9 week elective slot (for PE Health 7061 or any other 9 wk (.5) elective
- If you chose Modern World History: fill it in in block 4 for MP 1,2. This will leave one semester slot open for other
 courses, such as:
 - o 1. a doubled science (Chemistry) or doubled math
 - o 2. another elective course like ART
 - o 3. any 18 wk course
 - o 4. PE/Health 7061 and another 9 wk (.5 cr) elective

If you fill your schedule and did not make room for P.E./Health, you will need to make sure to find room in your schedules in 11th or 12th grade year to complete your required PE credit. Sophomores are strongly encouraged to complete their minimum physical education graduation requirements during their sophomore year.

CHART #1: Two Music Ensembles




CHART #2: One Music Ensemble
