í	Information: Blazer Academy is a five week after-school enrichment program offered to students in grades 1 through 6 who attend Bridge Valley Elementary School. Sign-Up Email →	Registration: Parents may register for the classes starting at 8:00pm on Monday, January 6 th through Thursday, January 9 th until 8:00pm using the MyPaymentsPlus program. Classes will fill up quickly, so it is recommended that if you do not already have an account through MyPaymentsPlus, that you create one prior to registration. Additional instructions on how to create an account and register can be found on the Bridge Valley Blazer Academy webpage. All payment will be processed through this Central Bucks endorsed payment program. Enrollment is limited for each class and is determined by the instructor. 	Wait List: In the event that a class has sold out, you can add your child to our Wait List. You can access that list the evening of registration by going onto the Blazer Academy website (through Bridge Valley's Homepage) and completing the Wait List form.
	Dates: Each class will be held one day during the week over a 5 week period. Blazer Academy will start at the end of January and end in March. Classes will be offered on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. Please see the brochure for the exact dates your academy will meet. Any classes canceled will be rescheduled.
