CB SOUTH GRADUATION PARADE LOGISTICS

Working in partnership with Warrington Police, Central Bucks High School South will be holding a Senior Graduation Parade on June 12, beginning at 9:00am and continuing in assigned waves through 12:30pm. This will be a rolling parade. Our faculty and staff will be lining up on school property following social distancing protocols to celebrate our graduates.

The Class of 2020 Senior Graduation Parade will begin in CB South's back parking lot and will conclude in the front parking lot. Prior to exiting campus, graduates will have the opportunity to plant their yard sign on South's front lawn. Only graduates will be permitted to be out of their vehicles and photo opportunities will not be permitted, as we must move along each wave of cars to keep the parade flowing – per the direction of Warrington Police. Graduates can return later in the afternoon – after 3:00pm – to retrieve their sign.

We will be organizing four waves of vehicles by Titan Forum (similar to Graduation Filming) and graduates are to report during their assigned times. While accommodations were made for Graduation Filming, we must adhere to Warrington Police's direction of 1 vehicle per graduate. You are encouraged to safely fit as many passengers as your vehicle permits, and you could also decorate your vehicle and/or make posters. Please locate which group your Titan Forum is attached to:

- Group 1 Arrival to South back parking at 9:00am and departing for parade route at 9:15am
- Group 2 Arrival to South back parking at 9:45am and departing for parade route at 10:00am

- Group 3 Arrival to South back parking at 10:45am and departing for parade route at 11:00am
- Group 4 Arrival to South back parking at 11:30am and departing for parade route at 11:45am

Parade Logistics:

Graduates and families must remain in their vehicles at all times.

Students and families will arrive at South in one car at their designated time listed above and line-up by following directions from Warrington Police and CBSD Staff. Vehicles will be led by Warrington Police motorcycles and a Warrington Township fire truck from the South back parking.

Attached is a google map of the parade route. All arrivals will be coming in via Pickertown Road entrance to the rear parking lot staging area. The front parking lot will be closed off.

Groups 2, 3, and 4 should access Pickertown Road via Lower State Road so that they do not get caught in the previous group's traffic pattern and possibly miss their start time.

The parade route is as follows:

- Exit from the rear parking lot (opposite direction near baseball/softball fields) towards Bristol Road
- Right turn onto eastbound Bristol Road
- Right turn onto westbound Pickertown Road from Bristol Road
- Left turn onto south Elbow Lane from Pickertown Road
- Right turn onto westbound Street Road from Elbow Lane
- Right turn onto north Folly Road from Street Road
- Left turn into the front parking lot of the high school from Folly Road.



Approx. 4.84 miles

Upon entering South's front parking lot, graduates may park their vehicle and plant their yard sign on our school's front lawn or if they prefer to keep it, they can continue through to the exit. This process will need to move efficiently to prevent a backup of cars on Folly Road. Staff will be moving along graduates in a polite and quick manner.

Students will then exit the parking lot, turning RIGHT ONLY onto Folly where families can then return home.

Warrington Police has suggested that any interested family who do not participate in the parade can stage themselves at Barness Field and cheer on the parade as it comes down Bristol Road.

We appreciate your assistance in making this a positive and smooth experience for everyone and special thank you to Warrington Police for making the Senior Graduation Parade possible.
