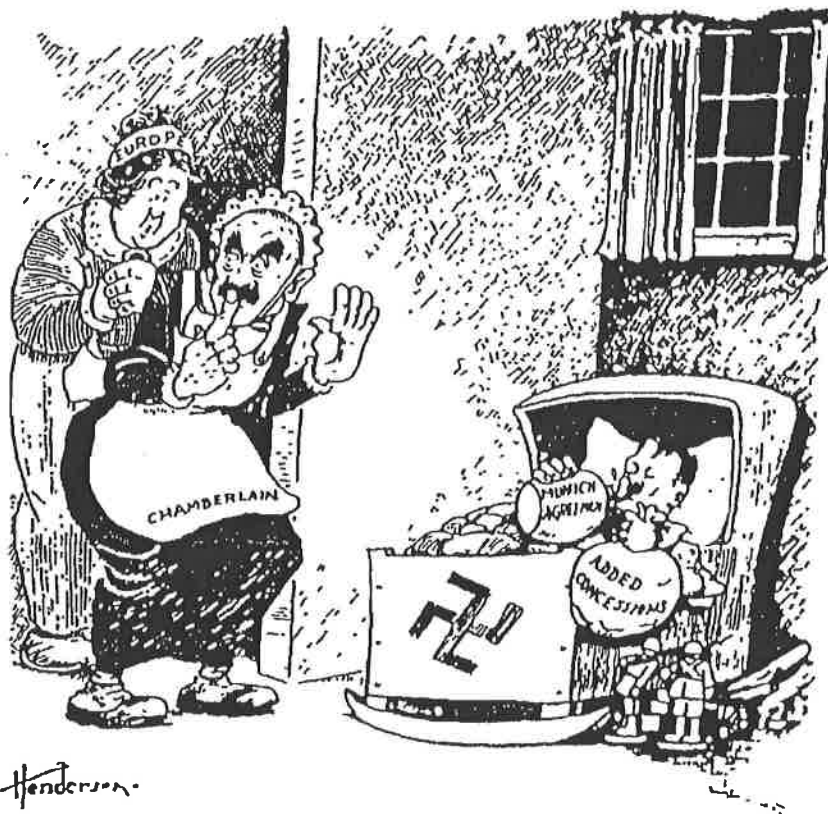


THE MUNICH AGREEMENT
