## Program Planning Update for 6<sup>th</sup> grade Parents – January, 2023

Program planning for 7<sup>th</sup> grade begins in late January. Students have limited choices for 7<sup>th</sup> grade; however, it is important for you to understand the process so that you are able to support your child.

**Overview of the Process:** Your child's school will overview the process of planning for 7<sup>th</sup> grade with the students. The Parent Orientation is important for parents to understand the middle school schedules and other transition considerations. We view the program planning process with students in two separate parts: core academic and electives. A general outline of each part follows.

**Core Academics:** Every student will have 5 core academic courses periods 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7. Every student takes the same course in science and social studies. Your child's current 6<sup>th</sup> gr. teacher recommends the leveling.

- English/Language Arts (ELA) which is taught at an academic or advanced level. ELA is also a double period ELA A and ELA B. Students may have the same teacher for both parts of ELA or two different teachers. Please discuss your child's recommendation with his/her current teacher.
- Math placement is data-driven and critical for success in the next course. If the teacher recommends a course during program planning season and changes their mind as the year comes to an end, they'll discuss that with you and let us know. Bear in mind that some students may need Math 7 before Pre-Algebra. We find this extra year of the basics in math is critical for success moving forward.

**Electives:** Our elective schedule flip-flops between A and B day regardless of the day of the week or days off. 7<sup>th</sup> grade electives are periods 1 and 2. Electives will include Resource, PE/Health, Innovation and Creativity(INC), and Integrated Technology for all students. The remaining electives are determined by student participation in Band, Chorus, or Orchestra (performance music classes). Performance music students will be enrolled in 1 of 3 electives and get the other 2 in 8<sup>th</sup> grade (Art, Engineering, or Family and Consumer Science). Non-performance music students will be scheduled for all 3 listed above.

**Verifications:** The last part of the program planning process is the verification window. Participation in Band, Chorus, or Orchestra should be determined with certainty on the verification sheet.
