## About the Central Bucks Save the Music Benefit Concert

For 19 years, the Music Department of the Central Bucks School District has teamed with the Save The Music Foundation to help save music education across the country. What started as a small concert and fundraiser has now grown into a 2-day event that features 3 concerts, nearly 30 professionals, and almost 200 students. The concert has raised over \$254,000 for the Save The Music Foundation since its inception. In both 2018 and 2019, the concert donation provided a core grant of over \$35,000 to save music at a school in New Orleans, LA and in 2020, the concert raised over \$48,000 to provide a core grant to a school in Newark, New Jersey.

This year's concert features an eclectic mix of music from artists such as Billy Joel, Britney Spears, Whitney Houston, Harry Styles, The Beatles, The Weeknd, and more!

All proceeds from the concert are donated to the <u>Save the Music Foundation</u>. This organization develops partnerships with school districts to build sustainable instrumental music programs by providing grants of brand-new musical instruments to public elementary and middle schools. Recipient schools have no other way of creating / restoring music in their schools. We are fortunate to be a part of a district with such an outstanding music program, and part of a community that embraces the arts. This concert is our way of giving back.
