• 4<sup>th</sup> Paragraph: 3<sup>rd</sup> body paragraph

• 5<sup>th</sup> Paragraph: Conclusion

## What each paragraph looks like:

#### Introduction

- 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> Sentence-Hook
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Sentence Connecting sentence
- 4<sup>th</sup> Sentence- Thesis sentence
- **5**<sup>th</sup> **Sentence-** Sub-topics sentence
- 6<sup>th</sup> Sentence Transition to 1<sup>st</sup> body paragraph

#### **Body Paragraphs**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Sentence-Topic sentence
- **2<sup>nd</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> Sentence**-Supporting details and tell-mores
- Last Sentence-Concluding sentence

#### Conclusion

- **1**<sup>st</sup> **Sentence** Restate your thesis
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Sentence- Summarize information in body paragraph #1
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Sentence- Summarize information in body paragraph #2
- 4<sup>th</sup> Sentence- Summarize information in body paragraph #3
- 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Sentence-Send your reader off with something to think about
