



Ski and Boarder Club

We are going on four trips this year to Blue Mountain. We will be leaving West at 2:15 to travel up to Blue. We will begin boarding busses at 8:45 and be on the road at 9:00 to return home to West at 10:30. The dates of our trips are:

Friday January 19

Friday January 26 - half day so we will leave West at 11:30 and leave the mountain at 7:30.

Friday February 2

Friday February 9 – pizza party

Friday February 23 – Make up date

Membership includes transportation and supervision for the 4 trips, a club sweatshirt and a pizza party on the last trip of the year. Club fees are \$145 to cover these costs and are separate from the lift passes.

Below defines the steps to become a member of our club.

1. **Complete the online club application on Family ID.** This should be completed before the mandatory parent meeting on September 28th at 7pm in the CB West Library.

 - Completion of the application does **NOT** guarantee membership. Attendance to the meeting, completion of the app, submission of all appropriate materials and a full payment does.
 - Be sure to print a copy of your application receipt e-mail or be able to prove the completion of the application using your cell phone.
2. Attend the **MANDATORY meeting in the CB West library on Thursday, September 28th at 7 pm.** This is the ONLY meeting of the season and is REQUIRED for BOTH a parent/guardian or family member and the student. * Mandatory attendance is a CB District requirement and not a CB West club requirement.
3. Bring the following documents with you to our meeting as they will be collected. Remember, this is a “first come, first serve” club so failure to complete the application and bring all completed forms will jeopardize club membership. Documents include:
 - A printed copy of your online Family ID application receipt (e-mail or cell phone verification)
 - **A check in the full amount of \$145 made payable to “CB WEST ACTIVITIES FUND.”**
4. During the meeting, families will be given information pertaining to the Blue Mountain registration and payment process. The cost for a student season pass for this year is \$229. Members will be asked to complete this payment process independently. All passes will be sent to CB West for the club adviser to distribute prior to the first trip. (Be sure to save any online receipts from this process as proof of payment).

SCHOOL GROUP OFFERINGS 2023/24 SEASON

STUDENT SEASON PASS \$229

For ages 6 to 22.

The off-peak student season pass is valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, and weekends/holidays after 4pm. Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 12th-15th, February 16th-19th.

Students registered by October 31st will receive a \$25 Blue Mountain Gift Card for free!

ADULT OFF-PEAK SEASON PASS \$500

For ages 23 +

Off-peak valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, weekends/holidays after 4pm. Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 12th-15th, February 16th-19th.

ALL-ACCESS SEASON PASS \$675

For ages 6+ Valid everyday all season long.

ADD-ON DAILY PICK-UP RENTALS \$90

All rentals must be picked up and returned the same day of use. If equipment is lost or stolen, the person whose name is on the rental will be charged. Their season pass will be suspended until the charge has been paid. When arriving as a group, a chaperone must accompany students to the rental area upon arrival and during the return process.

ADD-ON 1 LESSON \$25

ADD-ON 5-PACK LESSONS \$100

Lessons will be scheduled on the school's arrival dates.

CARVER CASH

Blue Mountain is cashless at most locations. Carver Cash can be purchased ahead of time, which can be used for anything on the mountain.
