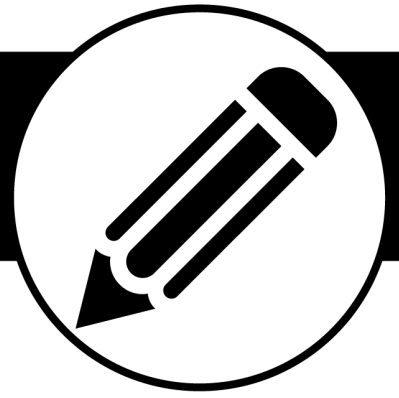
Summer Reading
