Program Notes

Bayou Breakdown was initially composed by Brant Karrick as an attempt to write a fugue in the style of J.S. Bach. The melody is introduced in a four-part fugue scored for woodwinds. A brief transition gives way to a second statement of the fugue by the brass. Another transition introduces a folk song-like lyrical theme based on a pentatonic scale. A brief transition takes the piece to its most dissonant section, evoking a poorly played waltz. The main melody attempts to reappear but is swept away by a progression of descending chromatic chords. After a complete stop, the initial fugue returns featuring solos by the clarinet, alto saxophone, oboe, and trumpet. After a few short trio statements of the main tune, the piece ends with a polyphonic flurry from the full band. The composer also describes his intent for the piece as follows. "In writing *Bayou Breakdown* I hoped to create a piece that would provide musical and technical challenges for performers yet could be immediately enjoyed by the listener, musician and non-musician alike."

Summer Dances was written by Brian Balmages for the Columbia Concert Band, Columbia, Maryland, for an outdoor summer concert. The piece was written to capture the beauty and spirit of the many festivals and events associated with the season. In writing the piece, elements were included to make it very appropriate to perform in or out of the concert hall. The piece thrives on rhythmic pulse throughout. The fast rhythmic figures of the opening are contrasted with the more stately motives presented later in the piece in the slower, more lyrical section.

Symphonic Suite from "Star Wars: The Force Awakens" is an arrangement by Jay Bocook of the famous soundtrack scoring of John Williams. The suite features the famous traditional themes of the original movies and the new themes of the most recent blockbuster phenomenon. The music is elaborate and scored challengingly. The suite is a tremendous opportunity for students to experience first class contemporary compositions from a world-renowned composer.

Program Notes

Symphony No. 1 “Lord of the Rings” was composed by Johann de Meij between 1984 and 1987. The symphony is based upon the famous trilogy by J.R.R. Tolkien which has fascinated readers since its publication in 1955. The five movement symphony characterizes important persons and events in the literary series. The first movement is based upon Gandalf, the second movement is called Lothlorien, the third movement is Gollum, and the fourth movement is simply called Journey in the Dark. The final movement, and only movement presented this evening, is Hobbits.

The fifth movement expresses the carefree and optimistic character of the Hobbits in a happy folk dance; the hymn that follows emanates the determination and noblesse of the hobbit folk. The symphony does not end on an exuberant note, but is concluded peacefully and resigned, in keeping with the symbolic mood of the last chapter of the books.

Foundry, by John Mackey, is subtitled “for concert band with ‘found’ percussion.” The piece is full of sonic exploration, and utilizes some exhilarating modern compositional techniques. The percussionists are asked to play extensive parts on almost every possible timbre available. Some instruments are labeled simply as “metal piles,” while the traditional instruments of the ensemble are also played. The music interprets the setting of a foundry literally and uses techniques similar to poetic onomatopoeia. In other sections there are sounds similar to traditional hymn techniques. Throughout the entire piece there is relentlessly driving pulse emblematic of machinery and industry.

Flight of the Pegasus is a traditional overture for band written by David Shaffer. The piece follows the format of a traditional fast-slow-fast composition, but the interior slow section is actually an extended accelerating waltz. This effect is exhilarating for both the performers and the listeners. The harmonic textures of the piece use many jazz-influenced seventh chords while voicing the textures in a traditional concert band form. The piece was composed in memory of Emil Puffenberger, a National President of the American School Band Directors Association and was premiered at the ASBDA national convention in 1993.
