Food:

Make sure you bring something to eat throughout the day to keep your energy up. After we rehearse, we will be packing up the trailer and heading to CR South. The bus ride could be a good time to eat. When we get to CR South, it's unloading, heading to Aaryn's classroom, last minute getting ready things, and then we're warming up. You won't have too much time to relax and eat once we get to CR South. After we perform, you can get something at concessions or eat whatever you bring with you.

Hair/Makeup:

Experiment with hair and makeup that you can do on show day on your own. Trying it for the first time on show day is probably not the best idea! Makeup will be given out at Tuesday's rehearsal!

Consider doing some of your hair and show makeup before arriving to our Saturday rehearsal and do touch-ups after loading the trailer or on the bus ride.

Other things to bring:

A pair of shoes that are easy to take on and off. You'll be wearing shoes to warm-ups and taking them off before we perform - (yes you'll be barefoot during performance). Also, bring a change of clothes for post-performance.
