**Oboe:** Sonata #2 - Handel - published as Sonatas #1&2--Carl Fischer #CU - 1385 - Movement 2 (Allegro)

**Bassoon:** Sarabande – Debussy/Paine – Columbia/Alfred #BWI00440

**Bb Clarinet:** Concerto in A Major K. 622 - Mozart/Kell - International #1878 - 3rd Mvt. (Rondo) only up to the first note (low E) of measure 311

**Bass Clarinet:** Ballade - Bozza - Southern #SS-287 - All

**Alto Saxophone:** Sonata - Creston - Shawnee/MS #LA0014 - Movement 1 (pp. 1 & 2)

**Tenor Saxophone:** Concerto in g minor - Handel/Voxman - Rubank/HL #04477528- - 2nd, & 4th Mvts. only

**Baritone Saxophone:** Ritual and Celebration - Jared Spears, Southern

**Trumpet:** Morceau de Concours - G. Alary - Concert and Contest Collection for Trumpet or Baritone - ed. Himie Voxman – Hal Leonard #04002518. Prepare the Andante (non lento) section and the Allegro energico section m. 1- 59, stopping at the 3 measure rest in the middle of the 5<sup>th</sup> system on the second page

**French Horn:** Concerto #1 in Eb Major - Strauss - International #1715 - 1<sup>st</sup> Movement only (up to measure 131)

**Trombone:** Concerto - Rimsky-Korsakov - International #1583 - Mvt. 1 beginning up to Letter D. Mvt. 2 – Letter G to Letter I

**Euphonium:** Southern Cross - Clarke - Columbia/Alfred #TS0029 – Start after the Cadenza and go to Pomposo

**Tuba:** Concertante - Walters - Rubank/HL #04479318

**Snare drum** candidates:

Solo #4 from Portraits in Rhythm by Anthony Cirone. Alfred Publishing  
All snare rudiments (see separate link on Auditions page)

**Mallet** candidates:

Violin Concerto in A minor, J.S. Bach / ed. Goldenberg. (Beginning of Allegro Moderato Movement to Downbeat 5th Measure of D). From "The Modern School for Xylophone, Marimba, and Vibraphone" by Morris Goldenberg. Alfred Publishing.
