Re: Halloween Parade (10/31/23)

Parents are cordially invited to attend Jamison Elementary School's Halloween Parade on Tuesday, October 31st. Students (Grades 1-6 and PMK) will begin circulating the playground at 9:10AM. The parade will begin at 9:15AM. You may observe the parade from the playground area just outside of the cafeteria. In the event of rain, please check your e-mail or the website for updated information. Parking is quite limited, so you may want to carpool or walk.

 Please avoid parking in the bus loading area if you will be assisting with a classroom party following the parade.

Our AM Kindergartners will have their parade indoors on *Monday, October 30th at 10:20 AM*. Visitors may enter the building and watch from the main hallway as the students circulate the building as they receive cheers from the other students lining the hallway. The parade will only be about one minute as the students pass by. Only party helpers will return to the classroom. The kindergarten teachers will send extra information closer to the parade.

Costumes:

Please help your child to exercise good judgment when selecting a Halloween costume. Costumes with a violent theme should be avoided. Weapons or accessories that could present a danger to others, even as "part of the costume," are prohibited. Your child should bring their costume in a bag marked with his/her name on it and he/she will change into it before the parade.

When in costume, students must have clear visibility and costume length should be in accordance with your child's height. Many children will be walking down the stairs in costume for the parade.


Classroom Party:


