

Kutz Elementary Science Fair March 31, 2020



Hello Kutz Students and Families!

Registration for the bi-annual Kutz Elementary Science Fair will be open **Jan. 30 -Feb 17th** . It's easy to participate and super fun – just ask the 200+ kids who came out in 2018! Students can do an experiment, collection or demonstration project. There is no judging for the science fair, but participation certificates will be awarded. All you need to do now is pick a topic (see Kutz Science Fair Web site for ideas) and decide if you want to do it individually or with a group of friends or family members. Then, each person completes the online registration form on MyPaymentsPlus (www.mypaymentsplus.com) and submits with \$5 payment by Monday Feb 17th.. If you do not have access to a computer to register online, paper registration forms are available in the Kutz Office or by contacting Pamela McClain at pmearsinpa@yahoo.com.

Key Dates:

- **Jan. 30** - – Online registration payment via MyPaymentsPlus by Feb 17th, .
Registration fee is \$5 per participant and covers the cost of the required display board.
- **Week of 3/2** – Display boards will be sent home with students.
- **March 30** – Science display set-up in the Kutz Gym 5-7 p.m.
- **March 31 – EXHIBITION DAY/ FAIR NIGHT!**
 - **Day** – Classes will visit the exhibition and learn from their classmate participants.
 - **Evening** - Official Science Fair Exhibition is open to entire Kutz community 6:30-8:00 p.m.
Teacher and parent volunteers will interview participants and award participation certificates.
Families and friends are welcome! Refreshments will be served!

Set-Up Details: Science displays must be set up in the Kutz Gym 5-7 p.m. Monday, March 30. Be sure your display complies with all Science Fair Rules. Science Fair volunteers will be available to assist you. Please indicate on the registration form if your project will need access to electricity so you can be assigned a spot near an outlet.
