

Directions:

1. Each child should receive a card that targets their speech sound.

2. On their turn, roll the dice 3 times. Each roll corresponds to one piece of the "star" sentence. Example: Roll 1- Subject of sentence, Roll 2 - Action of sentence, Roll 3 - Ending of Sentence

3. The student must say the sentence they rolled. Then, they are able to cross off those numbers of the sentence. (Example: If the student rolls a 2, 4, 8. They will go to Column 1 for the #2 Subject of the Sentence. Then, they will go to Column 2 for the #4 Action of the sentence. Next, they will go to Column 3 for the #8 of the sentence. They will state the whole sentence and mark off each number. If the number is already marked off, they can't mark it again.

4. At the end of the session, the person who has marked off the most of their numbers wins!
