I know your child is the most important thing in your life and I want you to know that I will do my best to make this school year a positive and fulfilling experience! Important Information

- 1. Our first day of school is **Tuesday**, **September 8th** and we will meet on **Teams at 9:05 A.M**.
- 2. You should have already picked up your child's laptop which we will use for daily instruction. In order to login, use the resources outlined in this SWAY. Please have your child practice logging on and off prior to the first day of school. Your child needs to know his/her username and password before logging in, so it will be greatly beneficial to practice this before our first day.
- Our schedule for the first week of school will be different than our permanent schedule. An academic schedule, including a schedule for specials, is currently being finalized by administration. Curriculum materials will be distributed next week, and a schedule will be sent out to the community.

- 4. During our first week, our focus will be on getting to know each other, teambuilding, and navigating Teams and Canvas. Building a strong sense of community will be my main goal! It is essential for our class to create meaningful connections, build confidence, and develop a supportive class community in our Online Academy.
- 5. Since your child is going to be learning from home, it is important to have a quiet space designated for schoolwork and the school day. I recommend that this is a place where your child can sit upright, just as they would in the classroom. It is also important to have school supplies readily available in this space. In your child's learning space, please have supplies such as headphones, paper, pencils, crayons, sticky notes, scissors, dry erase markers, a dry erase board and a water bottle available for use. Your child should also have an independent reading book readily available. Students will need their supplies ready to go during our lessons and activities so it will be important to have them easily accessible.
