National Board Certification Overview

Educators will submit four components that if successfully passed, will lead to National Board Teacher Certification. This collaboration allows educators to earn CPE or ESU graduate credits while getting support in preparing for National Board Teacher Certification. Additionally, by participating in this program, educators will also receive financial support towards the national board certification application fee.

Enrollment Options

Through this partnership, educators can opt to enroll in either CIU 20 CPE credits or ESU graduate credits in order to support them in the process of submitting and passing each component of the National Board Certification. Offering these two options creates flexibility for educators. The benefits of both options are listed below and a cost summary is provided on the reverse.

CIU 20 CPE Credits

CPE credits may be used for Level II Instructional or Educational Specialist Certificates

Up to 18 CPE credits may be used towards a master's equivalency

2 National Board courses with CPE credits meets the 5 year ACT 48 professional development requirement (30 hours per CPE credit)

ESU Graduate Credits

Graduate credits may be used for professional advancement

National Board courses may be applied toward several ESU master degree programs.

2 National Board courses with ESU graduate credits meets the 5 year ACT 48 professional development requirement (30 hours per graduate credit)

The National Board process occurs in a 3-year cycle.
