Today's event would not have been possible if not for the joint effort of the CB music faculty and the incredible LaMar family, whose strength, courage and faith over the course of the last few years has been nothing short of remarkable.

In my mind, I had written, revised and edited this "welcome" numerous times, and yet I still found myself struggling to find the right words. How would I approach this? When he was alive, Ron left an indelible mark on the lives of everyone with whom he came into contact. He championed music education and made his students love music as much as he did. Even in his passing he will continue to do the same, and this is what makes today - and all future Ronald LaMar Scholarship Concerts - so special.

Ron – you are gone but certainly not forgotten. You are not here physically but your presence is felt each and every day. We miss you and we love you. We are all better people just because you were in our lives.

On behalf of the entire Central Bucks Music Department, I would like to thank you for coming today in support of the Ronald W. LaMar Memorial Scholarship. It is truly a pleasure to see Ron's vision come to fruition, and we are thrilled that you are here to help us celebrate his life and legacy.

#### The goal of this scholarship is to identify and reward a student who:

Exemplifies some or all of the 5 pillars of the Ronald W. LaMar Scholarship

Creativity, Generosity, Leadership, Music, Passion

Has made a contribution to their community through music (in addition to school ensembles)

#### **Applicants must also:**

Maintain a *cumulative* GPA of 3.0 or better

Be an active member of at least one CB High School music ensemble during 12<sup>th</sup> grade

Be continuing their education at a college or university

#### The application packet includes the following:

Brief cover page detailing required personal information & 3 short answer questions

- 1-2 page reflection by the applicant
- 1 page testimonial from an individual other than a CB music teacher

2015 Recipient — Lauren Letherland

Lauren Letherland is a senior at Central Bucks High School South, where she has been heavily involved in the band program. She has participated in the marching band, symphonic band and jazz ensemble for three years, and for the past two years she has served as drum major of the marching band.

Lauren's musical service has included sharing her talents with children on life support at a pediatric specialty care center. She has also organized multiple service projects in order to give CB South marching band members the opportunity to help others. Lauren collected food items for a local soup kitchen and organized a collection for Operation Eternal Gratitude. In addition, she is currently running a fundraiser where, as a whole, the CB South music program will raise money to donate to cancer research. She has committed to West Chester University where she will be majoring in music education.

In her reflection, Lauren states, "There will always be someone there to put you down and tell you that you can't do something. However, I've learned that true passion and love overcomes all of that. I can't promise perfection, but I will always be able to promise my best self." The evaluation committee felt that, out of the seventeen applicants, Lauren best exemplified the core principals outlined in the scholarship application and embodied the personal qualities that best represent the "spirit" of the award.
