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Dividing Fractions

$$1) \quad \frac{4}{5} \div \frac{2}{4} = \frac{4 \times 4}{5 \times 2} = \frac{16}{10} = \frac{8}{5} = 1\frac{3}{5}$$

$$2) \quad \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{5}{10} = \frac{1 \times 10}{2 \times 5} = \frac{10}{10} = 1$$

$$3) \quad \frac{3}{5} \div \frac{7}{10} = \frac{3 \times 10}{5 \times 7} = \frac{30}{35} = \frac{6}{7}$$

$$4) \quad \frac{3}{10} \div \frac{1}{4} = \frac{3 \times 4}{10 \times 1} = \frac{12}{10} = \frac{6}{5} = 1\frac{1}{5}$$

$$5) \quad \frac{9}{10} \div \frac{1}{2} = \frac{9 \times 2}{10 \times 1} = \frac{18}{10} = \frac{9}{5} = 1\frac{4}{5}$$

$$6) \quad \frac{1}{10} \div \frac{3}{4} = \frac{1 \times 4}{10 \times 3} = \frac{4}{30} = \frac{2}{15}$$

$$7) \quad \frac{1}{2} \div \frac{1}{5} = \frac{1 \times 5}{2 \times 1} = \frac{5}{2} = 2\frac{1}{2}$$

$$8) \quad \frac{2}{3} \div \frac{2}{4} = \frac{2 \times 4}{3 \times 2} = \frac{8}{6} = \frac{4}{3} = 1\frac{1}{3}$$

$$9) \quad \frac{1}{3} \div \frac{5}{10} = \frac{1 \times 10}{3 \times 5} = \frac{10}{15} = \frac{2}{3}$$

$$10) \quad \frac{2}{10} \div \frac{2}{3} = \frac{2 \times 3}{10 \times 2} = \frac{6}{20} = \frac{3}{10}$$
