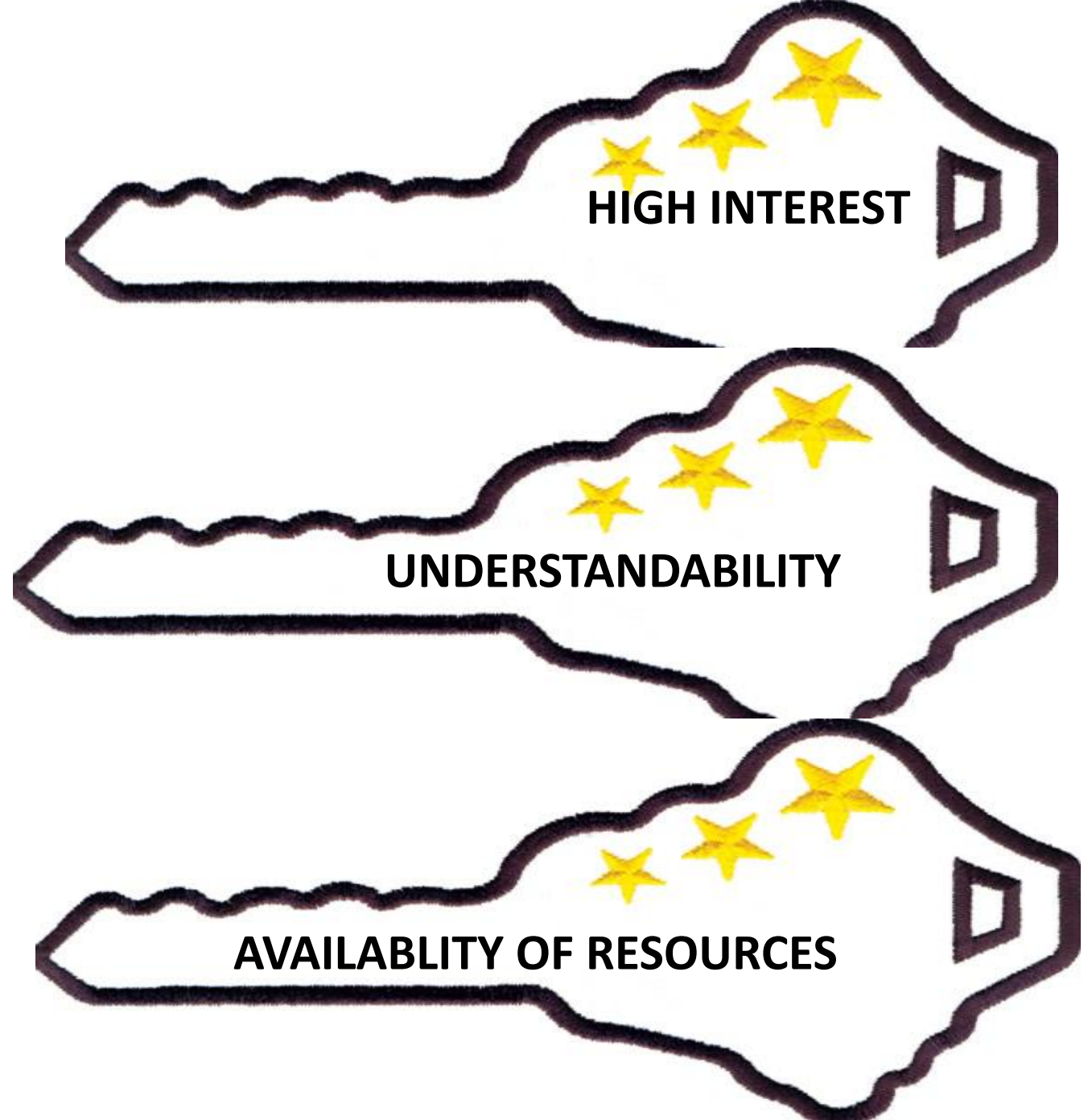

2. Make a Conjecture

3. Collect Information

4. Organize & Synthesize

5. Confirm or Revise Conjecture

6. Develop Presentation

7. Deliver Presentation

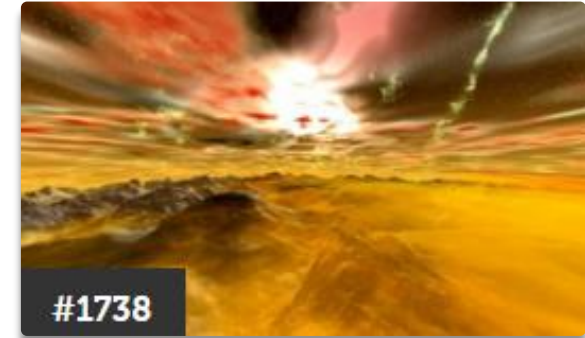
Sawfish
