Dear Kindergarten Parents/Guardians,

- All snacks should be <u>nut free</u> and easy for students to open and eat independently and quickly.
- Students may bring a water bottle that can be easily (but tightly) closed.
- Clearly label all personal items (backpacks, coats/jackets, hats, gloves, etc.)
- Students will need the following supplies. All supplies should be brought to school on Orientation Day!
 - one plastic two pocket folder with prongs (labeled with your child's name)
 - one 4-pack of Expo markers
 - one 24-pack of Crayola crayons
 - one pair of headphones (not ear buds) removed from packaging and placed in Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name
 - one box of tissues
 - □ AM- one container of Lysol/Clorox wipes, one box of gallon Ziploc bags
 - PM- one container of Wet Ones or hand sanitizer pump dispenser, one box of quart Ziploc bags
- Please note the following important dates:
 - New Family Ice Cream Social- Thursday, August 22 from 6:00-7:30pm
 - Kindergarten Orientation- Thursday, August 29 from 9:30-11:30am
 - First Day of School- Tuesday, September 3
 - Kindergarten Back to School Night- Tuesday, September 10
 - AM- 6:30pm
 - PM- 7:30pm
