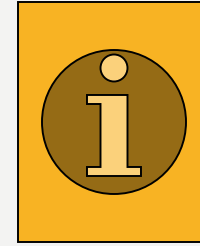

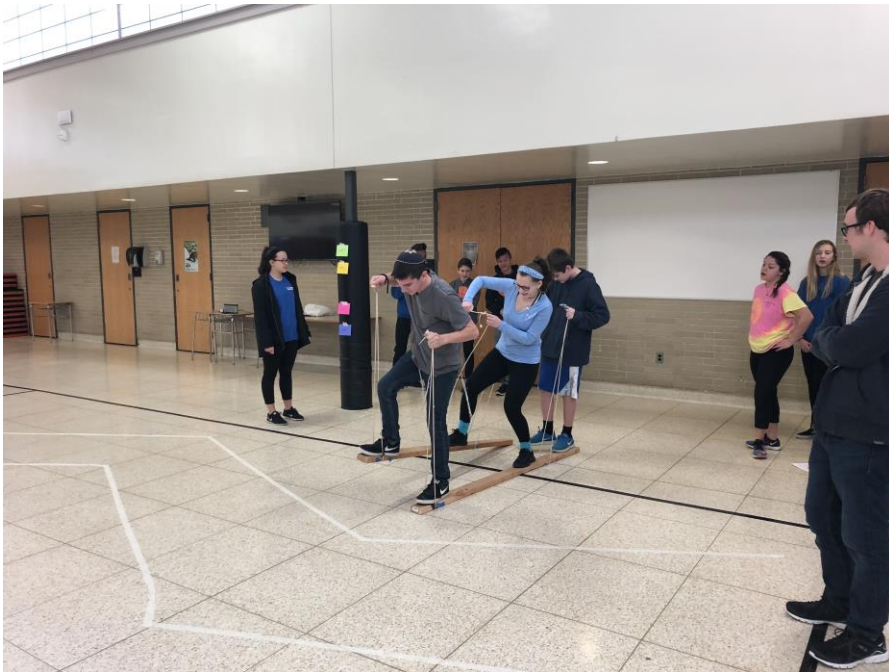

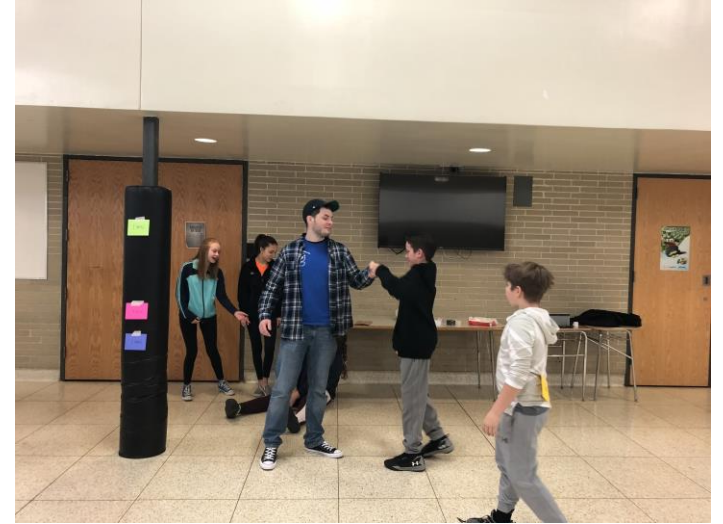


LINK 2 UNITY – SATURDAY, JANUARY 20!

 - Lay the groundwork for student leadership at Unami and for when they eventually move up to CB South

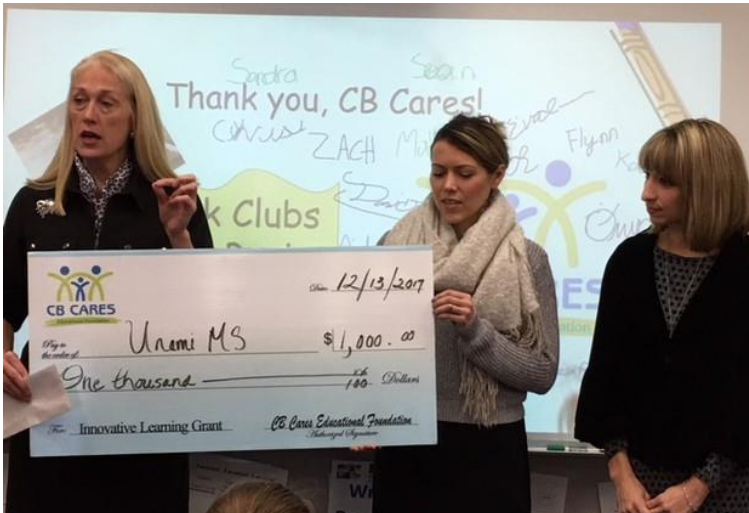

- Angst is a 56-minute film and virtual reality experience that explores anxiety, its causes, effects and what we can do about it. The filmmakers' goal is to have a global conversation and raise awareness around anxiety. Angst features candid interviews with kids and young adults who suffer, or have suffered, from anxiety and what they've learned about it. The film includes discussions with mental health experts about the causes of anxiety and its sociological effects, as well as help, resources and tools



ALERT

*Initial Alert may be a gunshot, PA announcement, etc...
Avoid code words.*

LOCKDOWN

*If Evacuation is not a safe option, barricade entry points.
Prepare to Evacuate or Counter if needed.*

INFORM

*Communicate real time information on shooter location.
Use clear and direct language using any communication
means possible.*

COUNTER

*As a last resort, distract shooter's ability to shoot accurately.
Move toward exits while making noise, throwing objects,
or activate alarm shooter.*

EVACUATE

*Run from danger when safe to do so using non-traditional
exits if necessary. Rallying point should be predetermined.*

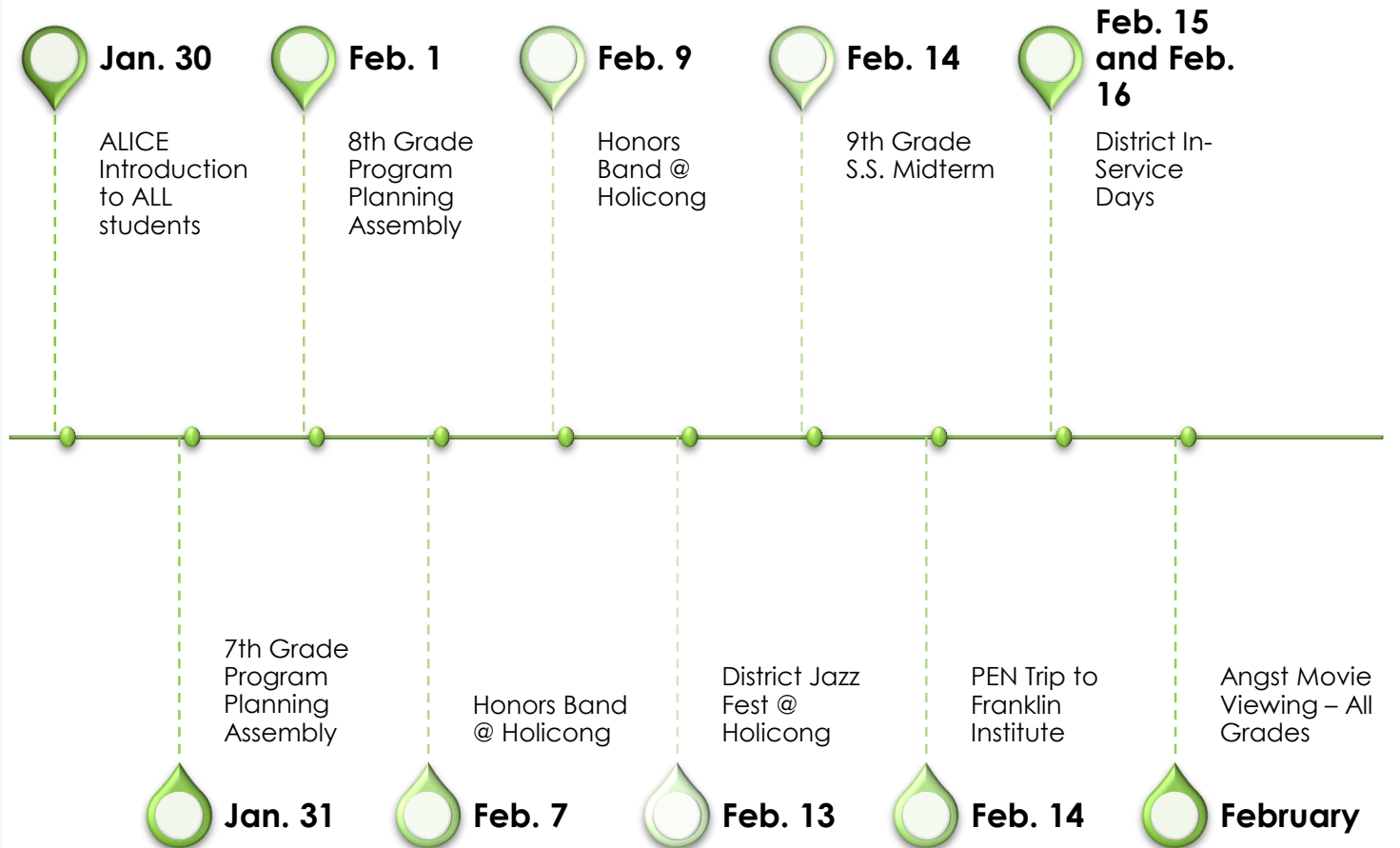
