

# ▶ HOW TO EMBED A TWITTER FEED ON YOUR TEACHER WEBPAGE



1. Begin by getting the URL for your Twitter page.  
Click on the name of your Twitter account.




2. Highlight and copy the URL of your Twitter page.




3. On your Twitter site, **click on your profile**; choose **SETTINGS AND PRIVACY**
4. Then choose **WIDGETS** from the left side of the webpage.




5. Click on **CREATE NEW** and in the drop-down menu, choose **PROFILE**.



6. Paste your **Twitter URL** into the widget box and click the arrow.



7. Click on **EMBEDDED TIMELINE**.



8. Choose **SET CUSTOMIZATION OPTIONS**

That's all we need, unless you'd like to [set customization options](#).  
By embedding Twitter content in your website or app, you are agreeing to the [Developer Agreement](#) and [Developer Policy](#).

9. **Enter the values** you want  
(I use 750 pt Height; 350 pt Width; you will see the Twitter feed below – you can change the values to see examples);  
then choose **UPDATE**.

10. Then, choose **COPY CODE**.

11. Go to your SchoolWires webpage and sign in with your username and password.




12. Choose the webpage you want to embed your Twitter feed on.


13. Choose **MANAGE APPS & LAYOUT**.




14. Choose **ADD APP**



15. Choose **EMBED CODE > CREATE NEW > NAME (i.e., Twitter Feed) > CREATE**



16. In design mode, you can drag the apps around to change the layout of your webpage. When you have it the way you like it, choose **I'M DONE**.



17. Choose your Twitter App and paste the HTML code from the widget (it should still be in your computer's memory) into the box and choose **SAVE**.



18. That's it! When you view your webpage your Twitter feed should be embedded.
