	Blank Screen	Quickly gain students' attention by blanking screens and locking down keyboard and mice.	 Configure Blank Screen Select "Class Settings" Select "Blank Screen" Enter a custom message (120 characters or less) Choose a background image Optional: enter a custom image URL (e.g. http://example.com/someimage.jpg) Select "Save" and then "Close" Use Blank Screens Select "Blank Student Screens" to toggle on/off Blank all students, is the default Blank one or more student thumbnails, use checkbox at top left Blank an individual student, select the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student's thumbnail, then click "Turn on Blank Screen"
¢	Limit Websites	Keep students safe and focused by limiting browsing to approved websites.	 Configure Limit Web Select "Class Settings" Select "Web Limiting" Select one of the following options: "Block all websites" "Block specified websites" - Enter website URLs or IP addresses one at a time "Allow specified websites" - Enter website URLs or IP addresses one at a time Select "Save" and then "Close" Use Limit Web Select "Limit Student Websites" Select the same button again to turn off Limit Web (toggle on/off) Optional: You can Limit Web per student by selecting the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student thumbnail then select "Turn on Limit Web"

Ō	Capture Screen	Take a screenshot to showcase exceptional student work in the classroom and share progress during parent-teacher conferences	 Select the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student thumbnail Select "View Details" Select "Capture Screen" (camera) to capture a screenshot of the student device Screenshot will include the student's name & a data/time stamp Note: selecting this icon will place the snapshot file in you computers' downloads folder

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	Respond to a Student's Raised Hand	Students can raise a virtual hand by clicking the hand icon in the Messages window	 Respond To Raised Hand Options Click the name of the student who raised a hand, and then message the student or lower the student's hand by clicking the hand icon in the student messaging window Click on the raised hand icon in the student thumbnail or in the list view to lower the hand
	Message All Students	Send a message to all students in the class	 Chat With All Students Click the "Show Chat" icon at the top right of the screen. The messaging sidebar opens, showing A drop-down menu that allows you to view "Classroom" messages and individual student messages A list of online students A Message to all students field for so you can type a new message to the class Type a message in the Message to all students field Press Enter to send the message to all on-line students Chat With Individual Student Click the "Show Chat" icon to open the messaging sidebar Click on the drop-down menu at the top and select which student to message Then type a message into the Message [Student Name] field Press Enter to send the message. Your message and any student responses display in the messaging sidebar
	Close A Browser Tab	Chromebooks only: Close an open student browser tab	 Select the "Change Class View" button Select "List View" Select a student in the list On the right side, under Current Websites, select the menu (3 dots) to the right of the tab you would like to close Select "Close Tab"
