

## **Quick Start Guide**

Feature		Description	How to Use it In a Class
	Blank Screen	Quickly gain students' attention by blanking screens and locking down keyboard and mice.	<ul> <li>Configure Blank Screen</li> <li>Select "Class Settings"</li> <li>Select "Blank Screen" <ul> <li>Enter a custom message (120 characters or less)</li> <li>Choose a background image</li> <li>Optional: enter a custom image URL (e.g. http://example.com/someimage.jpg)</li> </ul> </li> <li>Select "Save" and then "Close" <ul> <li>Use Blank Screens</li> <li>Select "Blank Student Screens" to toggle on/off</li> <li>Blank all students, is the default</li> <li>Blank one or more student thumbnails, use checkbox at top left</li> <li>Blank an individual student, select the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student's thumbnail, then click "Turn on Blank Screen"</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
¢	Limit Websites	Keep students safe and focused by limiting browsing to approved websites.	<ul> <li>Configure Limit Web</li> <li>Select "Class Settings"</li> <li>Select "Web Limiting"</li> <li>Select one of the following options: <ul> <li>"Block all websites"</li> <li>"Block specified websites" - Enter website URLs or IP addresses one at a time</li> <li>"Allow specified websites" - Enter website URLs or IP addresses one at a time</li> </ul> </li> <li>Select "Save" and then "Close" <ul> <li>Use Limit Web</li> <li>Select "Limit Student Websites"</li> <li>Select the same button again to turn off Limit Web (toggle on/off)</li> <li>Optional: You can Limit Web per student by selecting the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student thumbnail then select "Turn on Limit Web"</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



Feature		Description	How to Use it In a Class
<b>(↑</b> )	Push A Website	Save time and promote e-safety by instantly launching the same webpage on every device.	<ul> <li>Select "Push a Website"</li> <li>Enter a URL (e.g. www.lenovosoftware.com)</li> <li>Select "Load" <ul> <li>The URL is sent to all (or selected) student devices</li> <li>Click "Cancel" to dismiss the "Load a website" panel</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	Change The Class View	Changes the class view.	<ul> <li>Options Are</li> <li>Grid View</li> <li>List View</li> <li>Group View</li> <li>Chromebooks-specific Views</li> <li>Set All to Active Tab View <ul> <li>Default view for Chromebooks</li> <li>Set All to Desktop View</li> <li>Prompts students to share their entire Chromebook desktop, not just active browser tab</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
XS X-Small SM Small MD Medium LG Large XL X-Large	Resize Thumbnails	Changes the student thumbnail size (in all views)	Options Are • XS (X-Small) • S (Small) • M (Medium) • L (Large) • XL (X-Large)
53	Full Screen Thumbnail	View a student's thumbnail in full screen view	<ul> <li>Hover your mouse over a student thumbnail</li> <li>Select the "View full screen" button at the top right</li> <li>To exit full screen view, select the "Exit full screen" button at the top right</li> </ul>
Ō	Capture Screen	Take a screenshot to showcase exceptional student work in the classroom and share progress during parent-teacher conferences	<ul> <li>Select the menu button (3 dots) at the bottom right of the student thumbnail</li> <li>Select "View Details"</li> <li>Select "Capture Screen" (camera) to capture a screenshot of the student device <ul> <li>Screenshot will include the student's name &amp; a data/time stamp</li> </ul> </li> <li>Note: selecting this icon will place the snapshot file in you computers' downloads folder</li> </ul>

Feature		Description	How to Use it In a Class
	Respond to a Student's Raised Hand	Students can raise a virtual hand by clicking the hand icon in the Messages window	<ul> <li>Respond To Raised Hand Options</li> <li>Click the name of the student who raised a hand, and then message the student or lower the student's hand by clicking the hand icon in the student messaging window</li> <li>Click on the raised hand icon in the student thumbnail or in the list view to lower the hand</li> </ul>
	Message All Students	Send a message to all students in the class	<ul> <li>Chat With All Students</li> <li>Click the "Show Chat" icon at the top right of the screen. The messaging sidebar opens, showing <ul> <li>A drop-down menu that allows you to view "Classroom" messages and individual student messages</li> <li>A list of online students</li> <li>A Message to all students field for so you can type a new message to the class</li> </ul> </li> <li>Type a message in the Message to all students field</li> <li>Press Enter to send the message to all on-line students</li> <li>Chat With Individual Student</li> <li>Click the "Show Chat" icon to open the messaging sidebar</li> <li>Click on the drop-down menu at the top and select which student to message</li> <li>Then type a message into the Message [Student Name] field</li> <li>Press Enter to send the message. Your message and any student responses display in the messaging sidebar</li> </ul>
	Close A Browser Tab	Chromebooks only: Close an open student browser tab	<ul> <li>Select the "Change Class View" button</li> <li>Select "List View"</li> <li>Select a student in the list</li> <li>On the right side, under Current Websites, select the menu (3 dots) to the right of the tab you would like to close</li> <li>Select "Close Tab"</li> </ul>
