

Dual Enrollment

What is a Dual Enrollment Course?

- Dual enrollment courses will be in partnership with Delaware Valley University.
- When enrolled, students will receive credit on the Central Bucks transcript while also receiving college credits on a Delaware Valley University transcript.
- Classes will be taught by current Central Bucks teachers and will be available to current sophomores, juniors, and seniors during the regular school day schedule.
- Students should notify their counselor of their intention to take a dual enrollment course during their program planning appointment. They will then be directed to an online application requiring student and parent consent by March 20th.
- Families will be billed at \$100.00 per college credit by "DelVal," at the end of the second week of the semester during which a course occurs. If DelVal does not receive payment within 30 days of the invoice, they will automatically remove the student from the dual enrollment status in order to avoid collections.
- Students will be graded on the standard, non-weighted grading scale by the Central Bucks teacher, and grades will be sent to DelVal for entry onto the college transcript.
- As with all Central Buck courses, there is no guarantee that any dual enrollment course will fit in the student schedule.
