

 - Results are within a confidence interval of 99%, +/- 1%




Grade Level Distribution










When schools reopen, do you intend to send your child to school?






How concerned are you about your child's safety regarding COVID-19 once schools reopen?






What concerns you most about your child returning to school?




I believe that school should resume as normally as possible this fall with new procedures and guidelines in place to reduce the spread of COVID-19.






I believe that school should resume this fall with face-coverings worn by staff & students as well as social distancing wherever possible.






I believe that schools should reduce the number of visitors and volunteers during school days.






I believe that classroom desks should be spaced at least three feet apart.






I believe that we should have daily temperature screenings onsite by CB staff.






I believe that in-person instruction should wait until there is a COVID-19 vaccine.








Do you have access to a reliable internet connection?






Did your child need to borrow a district-issued device this spring for distance learning?










