



Hybrid (2 Days in Person – 3 Days Online)



- All staff and students are required to wear masks.
- Classroom desks will be arranged in rows with a minimum of **3ft. distancing** (more where feasible), with all students facing forward.
- Students will be divided into two groups. The district will take into account household relationships and assign all siblings to the same hybrid learning group.
 - Group 1 will attend in person Monday and Tuesday, and online Wednesday through Friday
 - Group 2 will attend online Monday through Wednesday, and in person Thursday and Friday
- Instruction on **Wednesdays will be a combination of live interaction (synchronous) and independent work (asynchronous) for ALL secondary students.** Wednesdays will also be used for:
 - Intervention and enrichment of student learning
 - Synchronous & asynchronous work for all students
 - Small group instruction/check-ins
 - Social and emotional wellness activities
- Secondary students with IEPs aligned with the PSSA/Keystone Exams will have the opportunity to attend school in person Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
- Students who attend **regional special education** classes will be grouped together and attend 5 days/week.
- **All in-class direct instruction will be live-streamed;** students who are learning at home will watch and participate in that portion of the lesson.
- Student **participation and attendance** is mandatory and expected for all classes, including days when students are not physically present in class.
- All students will be dismissed each day as follows:
 - Middle School 1:10 PM
 - High School 1:15 PM
- Students will have an advisory period twice each week (both in-person and virtually).
- MBIT students' schedules will be coordinated to ensure access to those programs.
- Students will use their **district-issued device** both in school and at home.
- While feedback will be emphasized, students will be graded using **regular grading practices in all classes.**
- A "grab and go" breakfast will be available for purchase before school.
- Due to social distancing guidelines, a traditional lunch period within the school day will not be provided. A "grab and go" lunch will be available for purchase at dismissal.
- Students will have time for a snack within the school day (snack not provided).
- As permitted, extracurricular events will occur after 2:45PM.
- On days when students who participate in extracurricular activities attend in-person, they will have the option to remain in school after dismissal in a supervised, socially distanced environment until 2:45 PM. Students may go home and return if they can provide their own transportation.
- On days when students who participate in extracurriculars are learning from home, these students will need to arrange their own transportation back to school to participate in those extracurricular activities.



CB Online Academy (100% Online)



- Students will engage in **virtual learning from home** by livestreaming direct instruction from their CB teacher, and by using Canvas as the LMS (Learning Management System).
- Students will have the capability to participate with classmates in an asynchronous environment.
- During **live instruction**, it is expected that students will attend and participate in a virtual setting. Asynchronous instruction will occur using Canvas and will also require students to participate.
- Teachers will establish and communicate **office hours** to provide additional support for students.
- Online teachers will instruct using the **CB curriculum**.
- **Assessments and teacher feedback** will continue to be a regular part of online learning.
- Student **participation and attendance** is mandatory and expected for all online coursework.
- Students will use their **district-issued device.**
- Student work will be graded using **regular grading practices.**
- IEP meetings will be held for each **student with an IEP** who chooses this model.
- Students who choose the online option may participate in extracurricular activities; however, they will need to arrange transportation back to school to participate in those extracurricular activities.
