Dear Central Bucks Winter Sport Parents and Guardians:

As we prepare to begin contests for our high school and middle school programs, I wanted to make our community aware of some restrictions we are currently navigating in our athletic departments. The [Order of the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health for Mitigation and Enforcement](#) provides the allowable rate for indoor capacity. Per the order, for indoor gatherings or events, all of our athletic programs must abide by the “10 percent or less” occupancy requirements. Student participants and coaching staff must be included in the total number of individuals that contribute to the 10 percent total. This severely limits our ability to host spectators as some of our venues reach the 10 percent capacity with just the participants in the contest. We are hopeful that these restrictions will be lifted, and we will be able to welcome our community back to our facilities soon. However, until these restrictions are revised, the following procedures are in place for all athletic events held in Central Bucks School District.

<u>Sport and Level</u>	<u>Number of Spectators</u>
High School Basketball, Cheerleading, Wrestling and Track	2 complimentary tickets per athlete at home games only
High School Swimming	No spectators due to capacity limits
Middle School Wrestling	No spectators due to meet setup and capacity limits
Middle School Basketball and Cheerleading	1 complimentary ticket per athlete at home games only

Tickets will be distributed through the athletic departments prior to the first home game. I also want to remind our high school parents that the Suburban One League has a no visiting spectator policy for the winter season, which prevents families from attending away contests.
