Hello Class of 2021 Students and Families,

CB West will be hosting the Senior Prom on Saturday, May 8, 2021 from 6:00 PM-10:00 PM at The Fuge, with a rain date of Wednesday, May 12, 2021 from 6:00 PM – 10:00 PM. If we exercise the rain date, Seniors attending the prom will have a half-day and will be permitted to leave CB West at 10:30am, after 2nd block. The Fuge is located at 780 Falcon Circle, Warminster, PA. 18974.

The purpose of this communication is to provide an update on the format of the prom, consistent with the Central Bucks School District Health and Safety Plan, as well as provide directions on how to purchase tickets. Please note that while our initial plans are provided below, some aspects may change based on the number of attendees.

Format: Students will enjoy music, lawn games, a socially distant photo booth, laser light show, and dinner. All students and staff are required to wear masks throughout the evening unless they are seated for dinner.

Ticket Sales: Ticket sales will take place on My Payments Plus <u>CLICK HERE</u> and will be available for purchase from <u>Friday</u>, <u>April 9</u>, <u>2021 to Wednesday</u>, <u>April 28</u>, <u>2021</u>. The price will be \$85 dollars per ticket. Upon purchasing tickets, students will be asked to sign up for their dinner table <u>in groups of 8</u> by designating 1 table leader. Each student will then sign up under the last name of their designated table leader. This will enable staff to plan properly. Any students that do not sign up for a table, will be placed at a table accordingly.

Based on our initial survey results and the number of students who indicated they will be attending the prom, we will now be allowing students to bring CB West underclassmen and non-CB West students as guests.

Arrival: Students will arrive to The Fuge by 6:15 PM. Upon arrival, they will present their school ID at the check-in table and will be given a wristband to indicate their dinner time.

Dinner: A covered, plated dinner will be served inside of The Fuge in two groups and in alternate locations in the main ballroom. Students will have the option for a chicken (which is also gluten free) or vegetarian entrée. Students will make their selection when they sign up to purchase tickets.

There will be two dinner times, to which students will be randomly assigned. Group 1 will eat from 6:30 PM to 7:15 PM and Group 2 from 7:30 PM to 8:15 PM. When Group 1 is eating in the main ballroom, Group 2 will be outside in the pavilion, and then they will switch. Table arrangements and seating times will be posted on the <u>CB West Senior Prom</u> tab by <u>Monday, May 3.</u> Students will have to use their district sign-in to access the list. Students will also be given a wristband upon entering the prom to indicate when they will eat dinner.

After Dinner: After Group 2 eats dinner, all students will be able to access three locations: music outside in the pavilion, music in The Fuge's main ballroom, and lawn games in The Fuge's secondary room.

Students Leaving Early: Students will be permitted to leave The Fuge at any time, on their own accord. Once a student leaves, they will not be permitted to re-enter.

We look forward to a fun and memorable evening while maintaining safety for everyone.
