

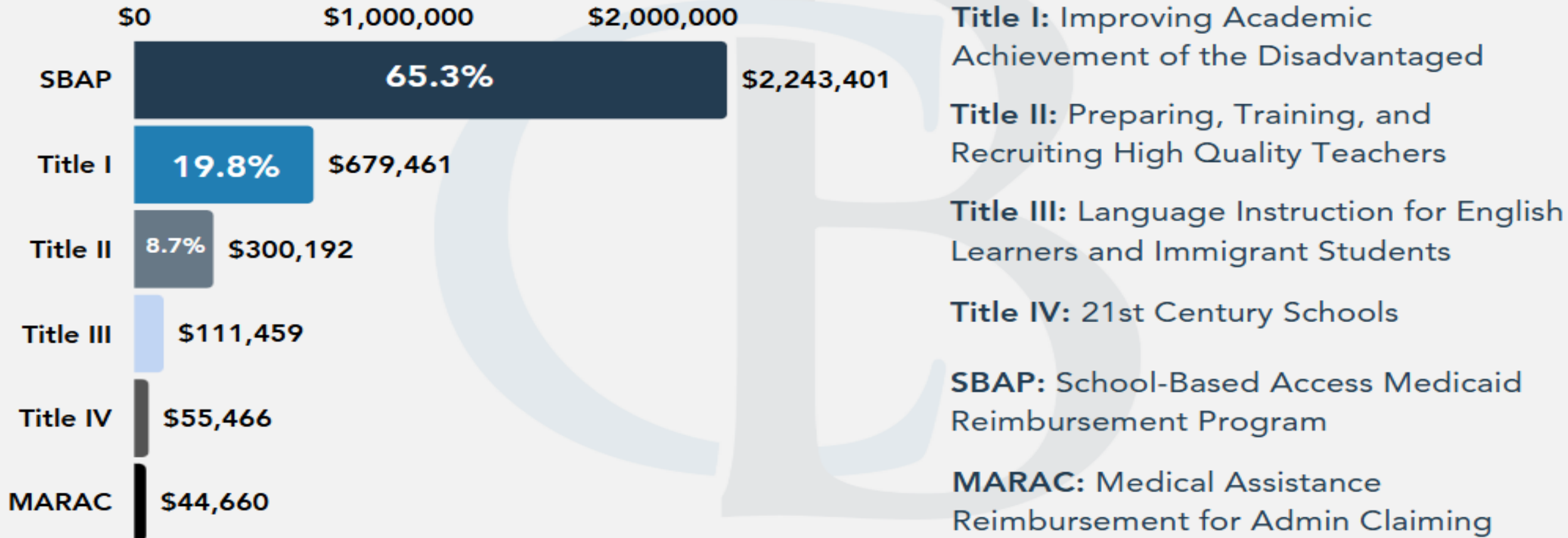

## What the U.S. Dept. of Ed. Does

### K-12 Education Funding

Title I Grants (approx. \$18B/year); IDEA Grants (approx. \$14B/year); Title II, III and IV Grants; Impact Aid; School Improvement Grants; Career and Technical Ed

### Higher Education Funding

Student Loans (over \$100B/year); Pell Grants (approx. \$300B); Federal Work Study; TRIO and GEAR UP Programs; Research Grants; Aid to HBCUs and Similar Institutions

### Additional Programs

Adult Education & Literacy Programs; Early Childhood Education Initiatives; Education Research & Innovation Funding; Civil Rights Enforcement; Data Collection & Statistical Analysis

## Important Info Regarding Funding

While 90% of the funding for local schools comes from local and state governments, the 10% in federal funding is significant because it focuses on low-income students and children with disabilities.
