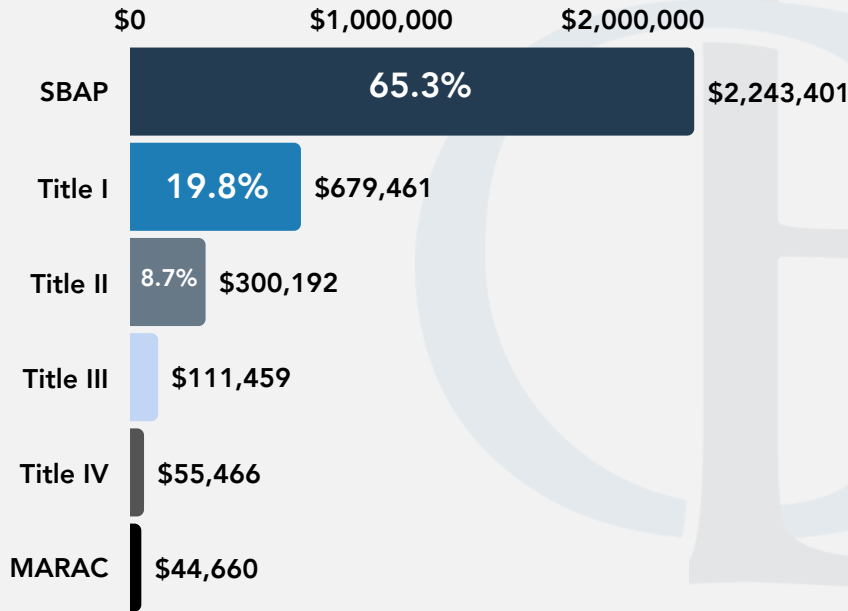

Financial

- Federal Funding Redistribution

Governance Changes

- Increased State Authority
- Reduced Federal Oversight
- End of Federal Data Collection

Practical Effect for Schools

- More Admin Burden on States
- Variability in Student Loan Programs & Financial Aid
- Changes to Accountability Systems
- Potential Reorganization of Research Funding

Impact on Special Education Funding

- #### Legal and Oversight Changes
