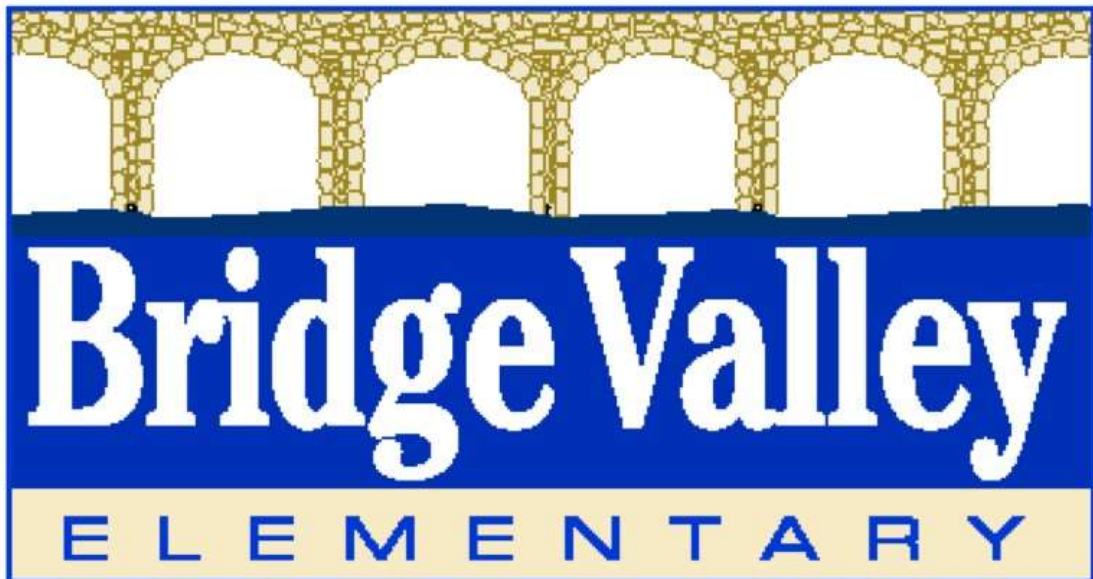

BRIDGE VALLEY ACRONYMS

Here at BVE, we have a few acronyms that are frequently used. Here is what we mean when we say

AGTS – Art Goes to School

BTSN – Back to School Night (held in September by grade level)

BVE – Bridge Valley Elementary

BVE Day – held monthly, usually the last day of the month

CC – Classroom Coordinator (Homeroom parent)

CMR – Community Meeting Room (conference room across from BV Library)

EOY – End of Year

HSA – Home and School Association

LGI – Large Group Instruction (the room behind the main center stairs)

PSSA – Pennsylvania System of School Assessment (annual standardized test administered to grades 3 thru 6 in March and April)

TC - Team Coordinator (1 – 2 per grade; liaison with CCs)

SUG – Sign Up Genius

BRIDGE VALLEY SUPPORT OPPORTUNITIES!!

Membership Drive (September)

Families are invited to offer an annual donation. From Oct to March, 5% of your purchase will be donated to Bridge Valley H&S every time you provide your rewards card. You can fill out a registration form and send it back, or stop by the registration table during Back to School Night.

AMAZON SMILE

You can also shop [Smile.Amazon.com](https://smile.amazon.com) from your computer and have it delivered directly to Bridge Valley H&S. Amazon Smile allows users to pick a charity and they donate .5% of every purchase to it. Simply go to smile.amazon.com.
