

Overview



- Increased time for RELA to allow for Reading Horizons (phonics instruction), My View (comprehension instruction), small group instruction, and writing instruction
- Embedded content (science and social studies) into purposeful play, morning meeting, reading, writing, math, and specials
- Increased time for math to allow for calendar math, Math in Focus, and small group instruction
- Increased special time and attendance of all 5 specials
- Added a WIN block
- Added purposeful play
- Added quiet time
- Add lunch/recess
- Increased time for morning meeting and closing circle

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

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Summary of Benefits in Schedule

Concern/Feedback/Area of Need	Win in the Schedule
Maintain sufficient instructional time	Did not reduce length of instructional periods; More instructional minutes 6 th – 8 th grade in Social Studies; More minutes 6 th – 8 th grade in Science; More minutes 6 th – 8 th grade in Family Consumer Science (Financial Literacy); More minutes 6 th – 8 th grade in Integrated Technology
Interdisciplinary teaming is important	Maintained teaming structure, included dedicated team planning built into schedule
Grade/Subject-alike team planning is valuable (PLC)	Increased Grade/Subject-alike (PLC) planning time; Removed this planning time from I/E so all teachers are available every day during I/E
I/E is having a positive impact	Maintained 40 minute I/E that is available everyday for students
Too much unstructured time when students have resource and I/E	Removed resource period from the specials rotation; This allows additional specials opportunities for all students
Need more instruction in study skills and decision-making	Creating a "Seminar" class to teach study skills and executive functioning to support decision making
Need for career guidance	Career-Readiness Benchmark activities done during new "Seminar" special
Student wellness is area of need for our students (includes physical health and need for social skills instruction)	Adding a dedicated Health special for all students in 6 th – 8 th grade; This also ensures students have physical activity every day they have physical education






Concern/Feedback/Area of Need	Win in the Schedule
Need more instruction in financial literacy	Added Family Consumer Science as a 6 th grade special (financial literacy)
Concern students in music ensembles cannot take all specials	Change from an A/B day rotation toa 4-day rotation will allow music students to be in music for full-year and also take all specials every year which aligns to true middle school philosophy
Student executive functioning skills are weak	Creating a "Seminar" class to teach study skills and executive functioning
Reading and writing deficiencies need to be addressed	Maintaining close to the same number of instructional minutes in 6 th grade; Adding a scheduled MTSS ELA class in 7 th and 8 th grade for students who require interventions; MTSS ELA class will not impact student specials
Deficiencies in various math skills impacting several areas of instruction were mentioned	Maintaining 6 th grade math instructional minutes; Adding a scheduled MTSS Math class in 7 th and 8 th grade for students who require interventions; MTSS intervention class will not impact student specials
Deficiencies in technology skills including file management, digital citizenship, use of learning management systems, office applications	Adding Integrated Tech as a 6 th grade special





Highlights

- 7 period day + an I/E period (same as current MS Schedule)
- 6 core instructional periods and 1 period of special (This is the same as current 6th grade instructional day)
- **Core Classes:** 1 period Social Studies, 1 period Science, 2 periods of ELA and 2 periods of Math This more than doubles the Social Studies and Science instructional minutes over the course of the year and keeps the amount of ELA and Mathematics instructional minutes as close to the same total of instructional minutes as possible over the course of the school year.
- Specials Classes: Art, FCS, STEAM 1(Tech Ed Department Wants to Rename classes to STEAM), Physical Education, Health 1, Integrated Tech 1, General Music or Ensemble Music (Band, Choir, Orchestra), a new special called 6th Grade Seminar (Study Skills, Executive Functioning Skills, Career Readiness Benchmark Work) – Students receive all specials.
