Dear Parent/Guardian,

The Pennsylvania School Health law requires all students entering **Kindergarten** to have a medical and dental examination.

Since your child will be attending elementary school in the fall, we wish to bring to your attention these required <u>state mandated</u> physical and dental examinations. **Examinations can be accepted if performed after September 1**<sup>st</sup> of the previous **year.** The completed forms must be returned to the nurse's office <u>no later than October</u> <u>15<sup>th</sup></u> of the current school year and will become part of your child's permanent school health record.

It is strongly recommended that you have these examinations done by your private practitioners since they can best assist you in obtaining any necessary treatments or corrections. If this is not possible, please sign below indicating that you wish the examinations to be performed at school and return it to the health room.
