


as Janis/Transformer



### **END NOTES**

I think HS theatre directors would concede that most high school theatre clubs are typically more female than male, and that most musicals and plays have more male characters. This is obviously not the ideal equation for a girl in the performing arts in 2024.

Mean Girls was already slated for the Harlequin Club's 2023/24 season when I stepped across the threshold in October. When I saw the deep and talented pool of girls here, and the resounding enthusiasm for a female forward musical, this choice made perfect sense to me!

Mean Girls the musical premiered on Broadway in 2018, with a book by Tina Fey, lyrics by Nell Benjamin, and music by Jeff Richmond. It is based on Fey's 2004 film of the same name that many of us saw twenty years ago this year! (and it's still relevant) The musical tells the story of Cady Heron, a teenage girl who transfers to an American public high school after growing up in Kenya. She is befriended by "non joiners" Janis and Damian who persuade her to infiltrate the "Plastics," a clique of popular but mean girls- Gretchen, Karen and the iconic Regina George, a self-proclaimed "massive deal." A web of conspiracy, secrecy, manipulation, and hilarity ensues as Cady discovers what it really means to become a "mean girl" and what she could lose in the process.

As I began to work on the show, I couldn't help but notice the personal correlations. Like Cady, I not only spent my childhood in Africa, but I was born there too. While Cady is clearly a displaced American teen, I was similarly the "foreign" kid in a new school. After her first classroom introduction ends in rejection, I could completely relate to Cady's burning desire to fit in. Despite the tongue in cheek jokes, quirky humor and super catchy songs, these high school hallways are real, unforgiving, and sometimes crass, but so is high school (hence the PG-13 rating.) But woven throughout this cheeky script are poignant moments that explore the universal themes of friendship, honesty, acceptance, and individuality.

In scene study we have explored the personas that these teens create to shield themselves from rejection and insecurity. We recognize that bullying is still alive and well in high school, both in person and especially on social media, and that often the most hurtful things are said by the people closest to you.

Ultimately girls just want to feel empowered like in Janis' song "I'd rather be me." They want to be acknowledged and accepted, not just by boys but more often by other girls. I find it interesting that the main male teen characters in this show, aren't adversaries but are advocates for sincerity, and actually help Cady rediscover how singular, smart, kind, and resilient she really is at her core. The show is deceptively challenging to direct. Dialogue, songs, scenes and costume changes happen sometimes simultaneously and one moment segues to the next more like a film than a stage production (which makes sense given its predecessor.) With another short rehearsal schedule this spring, I couldn't be prouder of our cast, crew, adult volunteers, and our incredible creative team for working so collaboratively and tirelessly to bring this show to life. You are all so fetch!

SPECIAL THANKS! I want to offer a special thank you to Suzanne Safran as she steps away from the Harlequin Club after this year. She hadn't intended to stay on for 2023/2024 school year, but she came back to captain the ship in this transition, and make sure that the new director would be supported and settled in their role before she made her exit. I don't think everyone knows how much Suzanne does behind the scenes and the overwhelming time commitment and personal sacrifice this has been, purely out of love for this club and a deep desire to leave it in a good place. I would like to thank her for supporting me in this transition and helping me acclimate. I wish her the very best. I hope she will continue to come back and see what we are up to. I would like to also welcome Brandyn Taurino, our new producer for next year. She has been seamlessly transitioning into this new role with Suzanne's help. Please welcome Brandyn to the team and offer your thanks to Suzanne for being such a great caretaker of this organization. She will be missed!
