Level of Misbehavior	Consequences
Level One: Misbehaviors that interfere with the orderly learning environment of the school. An infraction of the Code of Conduct. Examples are:  Continuous calling out in class Note passing, etc. Teasing, name calling	Level One consequences may include, but are not limited to:  O A conduct report O Restriction or loss of a privilege O Parent notification O Verbal or written apology to people affected by the misbehavior.
Level Two: Frequent or serious misbehavior that disrupts the learning environment of the school, or a second infraction of the Code of Conduct. Examples are:  • Cheating • Defacing school property	Level Two consequences may include, but are not limited to:  O All consequences from Level One O Parent and student conference with school personnel O Office referral Before or after school detention
Level Three: Misbehaviors that have the potential to endanger the well being of other staff or students, or a third infraction of the Code of Conduct. Examples are:  • Fighting and physical aggression • Bullying	Level Three consequences may include, but are not limited to:  O All consequences from Level Two O In-school or out of school suspension with a meeting of student, parents, and school personnel before returning to the classroom. O Replacement or repair of damaged property.
