## DO:

- ✓ Utilize a DSLR Camera if available for the highest quality photos.
- Find a replacement photographer if you yourself can't make the party/event.
- Upload all photos you would like to see on the classroom page within 72 hours of the party/event.

## DON'T:

Please don't upload photos of children chewing food, making bunny ears, etc. Even if it seems fun at the time it may be a sore point for others or be cause for teasing later.

Vpload photos of one child only with the teacher, keep those for your home albums.




