- II. Principal's Report
 - a. Mr. Croyle showed photos of the new playground. The school district purchased the playground. The remaining structure, GaGa pit is the intended next addition. The price for the pit is approximately \$6,000-\$7000. The attendees of the general membership meeting voted yes to purchase the GaGa pit up to the ear-marked \$4000. A donor has offered to pay the difference. The GaGa pit likely to be installed by mid-spring.
