- I. Call to Order 1:30
- II. Principal's Report
  - a. Mr. Croyle discussed the service projects in conjunction with our building theme "We Can"
    - i. January 25- Day of Service projects were items handcrafted by students for residents of The Bridges. Items such as knotted blankets, sun catchers, cards were delivered by Mr. Croyle and Mr. Hottenstein
    - ii. February – Collecting canned goods to be donated to food pantry. At the talent show on February 25, families can bring a canned item to donate
    - iii. February – Pennies for Patients – students/families and staff were able to vote with a donation. The kids will vote by putting their change/money in a particular donation jar that will be in the cafeteria. The staff member who raises the most money will have to complete a challenge at an upcoming assembly. For example, Mr. Croyle singing song from Frozen, dressed as Elsa.
    - iv. March – Sock Drive in conjunction with the Giving Tree Foundation. Families will be asked to donate a new pair of men's socks or snack. On March 15, each pair of socks will be stuffed with a snack (granola bar or crackers) by the students
    - v. April – Clothing drive in conjunction with A Women's Place. Donated clothing is sold in their stores to women in need who receive a voucher to shop
  - b. Talent show was rescheduled due to inclement weather. The format is similar to reality show style. "Jamison's Got Talent". There is a temporary 'sheet' as a screen to project back stage activity. Jamison is inquiring

within the district to obtain a permanent screen to use at assemblies to see from the back

- c. Cold Spring elementary unfortunately had a fire this month. Jamison will be collecting donations for one week. Mr. Croyle will deliver donation next week. Jamison staff will be purchasing pizzas and salads for Cold Spring staff to show we are thinking of them during their time of adjustment post fire
