II. Principal's Report

A. Playground Equipment

1. Mr. Croyle announced that the School Board approved the purchase and installation of new playground equipment. Install Nov-Dec 2019. Pictures were put on the whiteboard for everyone to see what the structure will look like upon completion.
2. A Gaga pit would be an additional structure Mr. Croyle would like to add for the children. It would be installed by the school district but paid for by HSA budget. The cost is approximately \$8000.00. To be determined how to move forward as donations are still being sent in.

B. Off Campus Drill

1. Mr. Croyle will be introducing a new location for the off campus drill/evacuation, weather permitting, on 10/23. The previous location to St. Cyril is only ideal during necessary evacuations if buses arrive in a timely manner. The walk through the "Woodfield" neighborhood to a soccer field is a safer (for walking) and more immediate solution for off campus emergencies/evacuation.

C. Accelerated Math program

1. Mr. Croyle provided a handout that showed the 'math path' in which a student who is in grade level math vs. a student who in accelerated math (5th) or pre-algebra (6th). The manner in which a student meets the criteria to be offered accelerated math/pre-algebra was explained, and the thoughtful process behind it. The possibility in which a student can take more challenging/advanced math classes in high school isn't negatively affected by the math taken at the elementary school level.
