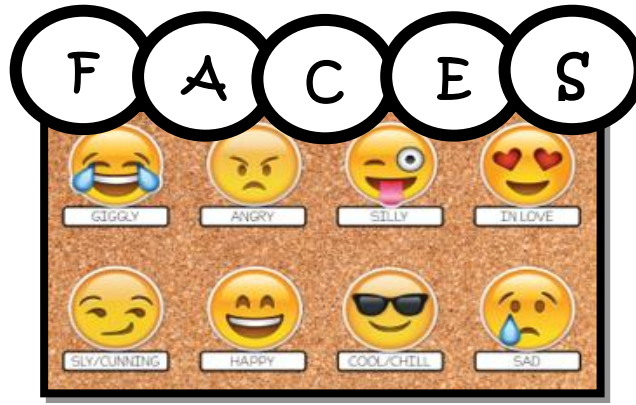


2018 Summer Reading Challenge
